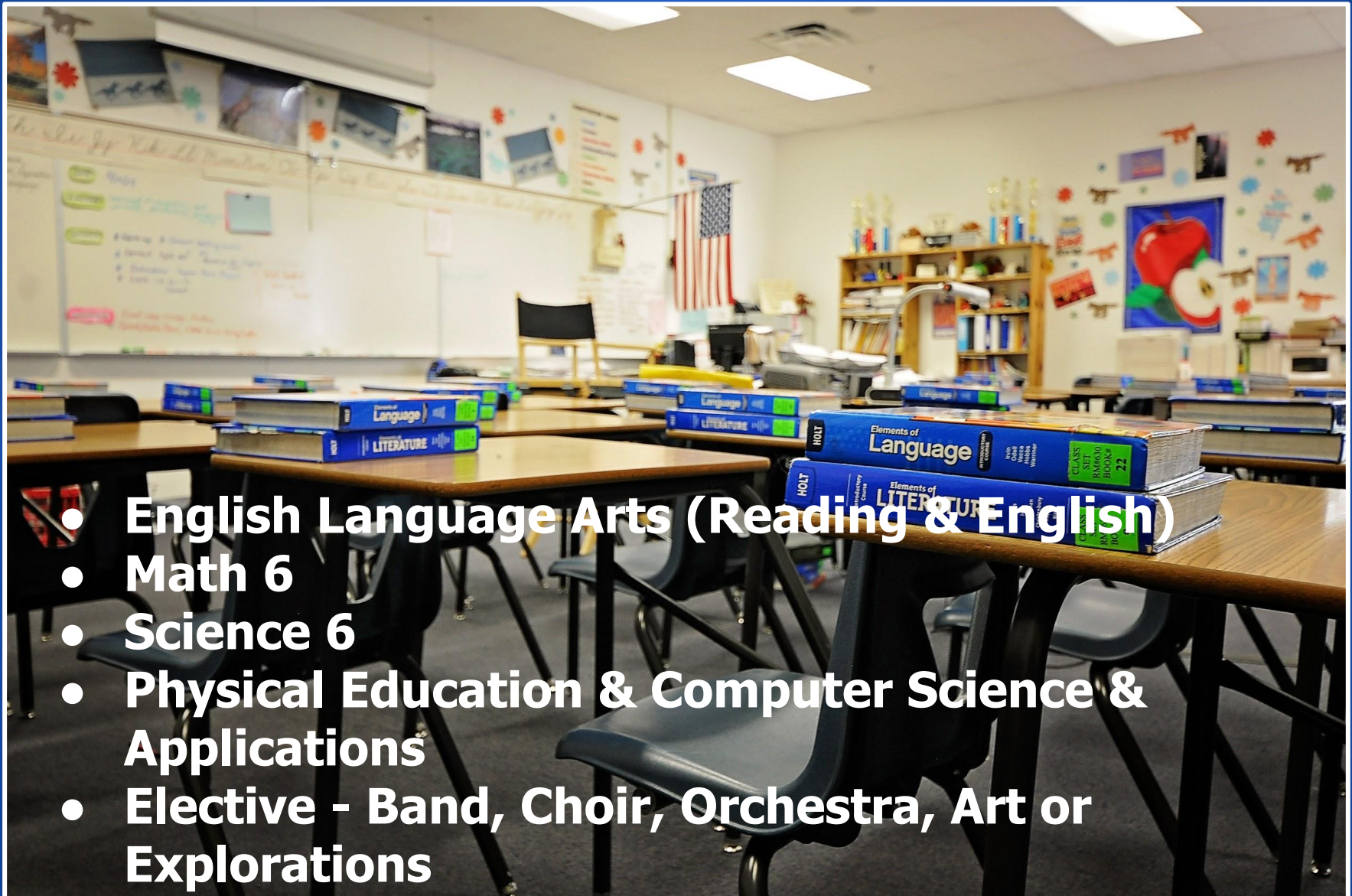





# Physical Education

- PE classes are both boys and girls with same gender teacher supervising locker room.



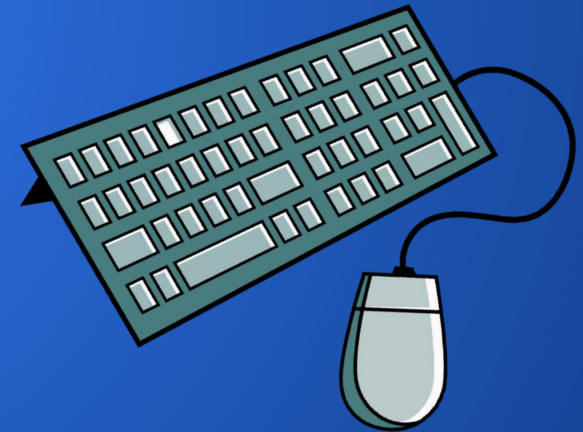
# Physical Education Uniforms

- Students do not need PE uniforms until the first Friday (5th day of semester).
- A set (shirt & shorts) cost \$20
- Students purchase uniforms on the 2nd through 4th day of the semester they have PE
- Students learn if they have first or second semester PE at 6th Grade Orientation or Back to School Day or 1st day of school
- PE Uniforms may be purchased on the webstore with debit/credit card or in PE class with cash.

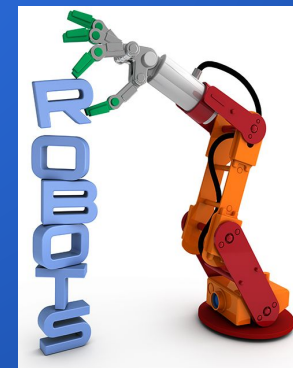

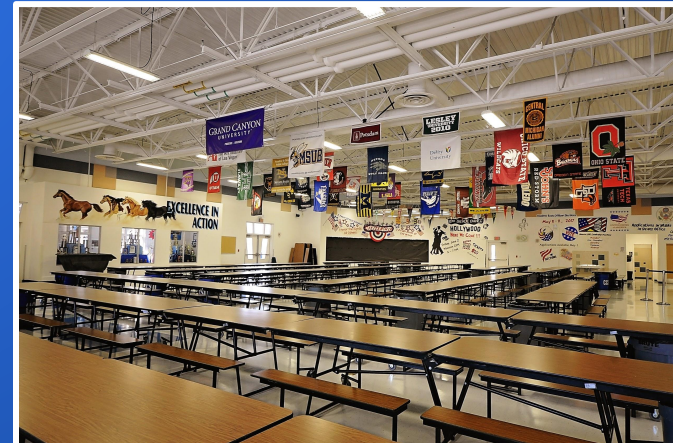
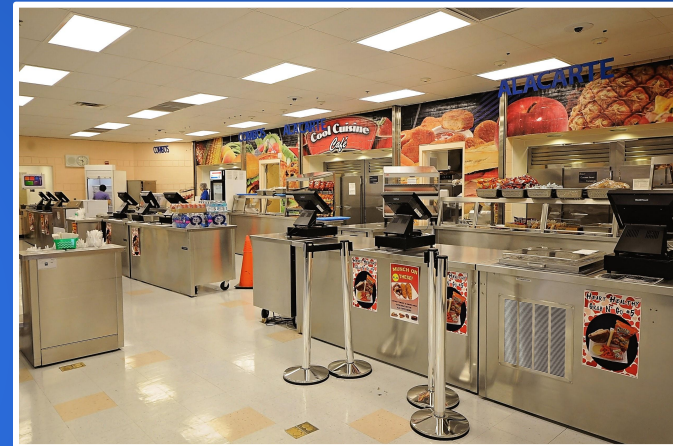

# Student Safety - #1 Priority

- **School Security Gate:**
  - All guests must check in and out at the Main Office
  - All entrances secured during school day

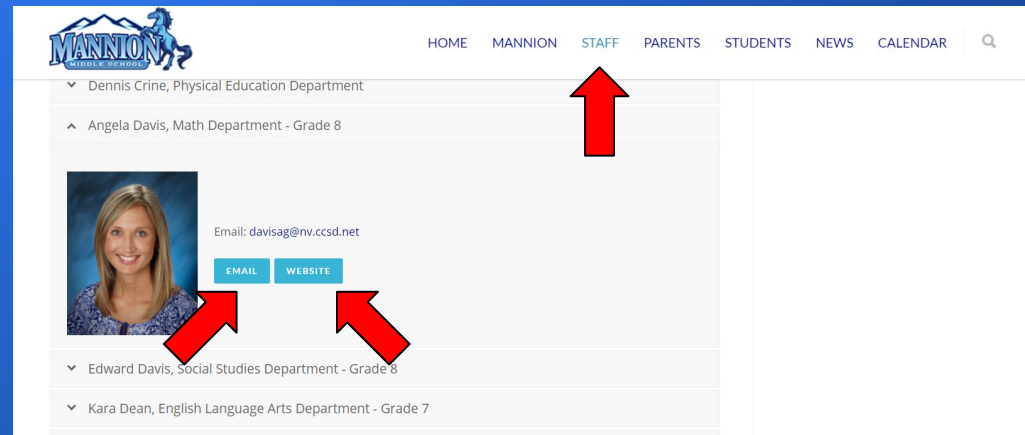

# **BEFORE purchasing school clothes . . .**

- **Shorts & skirts – must fall 3 inches above knee**
- **No sagging pants with underwear showing**
- **No bare-midriff, low-cut, or off-the-shoulder shirts**
- **No open back tops or dresses**
- **Undergarments may not be showing**
- **No sleeveless shirts or tank tops - min 3 inches wide strap**
- **No flip flops, beach sandals, or slippers**
- **No ripped or frayed clothing 3 inches above the knee**
- **No hats or hoods unless inclement weather and only before/after school in the Quad**
- **No spiked/studded clothing or jewelry**
