- c. Addition of 1 Learning Strategist (Loss of \$82,159.68) with Prep Buy & Add On Days.

Miscellaneous Items for 2019-2020

- Lanyards will be still be used. Mannion will be participating in a pilot program using ID's.
 Teachers will scan student ID's to check and verify attendance. This can also be used for office purposes.
- II. Local middle schools will be not be participating in additional sports. Mannion has decided to do the same (not enough supervision available)
- III. 6th and 7th grade awards ceremonies will be eliminated. 8th grade ceremony will continue.
