# • Instructional Prep Buy Outs; \$7,000 for two teachers for 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer School course (Math Only)

**SOT Comments:** District no longer funding 6th grade summer school (in person) so students that fail will not have access to personal instruction. NVLA offered as of current. For 6th graders, online version is not good but district decided to cut it. We will offer 3 week, 5 days a week, 5 hours a day math summer school. 6th grade and 7th grade teacher available to do it. Skills will be built to help with 7th grade needs. Two teachers are required so group can be divided into smaller groups. Students will be billed. Financial assistant offered if necessary. Computers given to students that need an online situation for NVLA if necessary. Maybe 30 kids. 20 kids good to do it. June 4th through June 22nd. Teachers will be paid a total of 6 hours per day. **Public Comments:** No public comments were given.

**Vote**: Rachelle Abbott made a motion to approve the prep buy-outs. The motion was seconded. There was a counted vote with 9 in favor and 0 opposed. (Kym Rodriguez and Michelle Reilly did not vote as they were not present at this time.)
